



DTE Energy chief to testify about utility regulations

DTE Energy Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Anthony Earley Jr. will testified before the Michigan House of Representative's Energy & Technology Committee Wednesday morning about changes to the state's utility regulatory environment.

Earley is expected to call for the repeal of the Electric Choice provisions of Michigan Public Act 141, which was adopted in 2000. His testimony is also expected to encourage greater use of renewable energy sources, energy efficiency, the building of more power plants and the creation of a new "incentive based" regulatory system.

DTE Energy, parent company of Detroit Edison and Michigan ConsolidatedGas Co., is the state's largest power company.
