



Group Says Energy Law isn't Working

According to a watchdog group, a law that was passed more than a year ago to help electric customers in the state is failing. The customer choice coalition says the act was supposed to keep electric rates down, but now says customers are paying more than ever before. The group says the bill was also supposed to promise more renewable energy and tighter efficiency standards and after one year. No real progress has been made.
